CONDITIONS OF PROBATION (Reporting)

The Court has placed you on Reporting Probation with the expectation that you use this opportunity to prove to yourself and to others that you are capable of living a socially acceptable life as a productive, responsible and law-abiding member of society. Probation is not a form of leniency, but rather a form of treatment consciously chosen because there is reason to believe that the objective of justice will be fulfilled and the interests of society protected, while at the same time, balancing your needs as the offender.

A Probation Officer will be assigned to work with and to help you make an acceptable social adjustment. The Probation Officer will help you in every way possible from being available for counseling when problems arise to submitting regular reports of your progress to the Court to ensure compliance of Probation.

It is the Probation Officer's duty to require you to live by the conditions of Probation. The Probation Officer has the authority and responsibility to enforce these conditions by notifying the Court of any violation and recommending your appearance before the Court as a Probation Violator.

Your goal is to terminate your sentence successfully. This can be accomplished if you demonstrate an acceptable attitude and conduct yourself as a productive, responsible and law-abiding member of society.

The conditions of Probation have been carefully designed as guidelines for acceptable Probation behavior. If you should violate one or more of these conditions of Probation, the Court has the legal authority to revoke your Probation and commit you to a state institution or community corrections to serve your sentence.

FINANCIAL AGREEMENT:

In addition to other conditions of Probation, all individuals on Reporting Probation shall pay an Initial User's Fee, an Administration Fee and a Monthly User's Fee of \$20.00/\$30.00. These Fees are to be paid to the Switzerland County Probation Office by the first week of each month unless other payment arrangements are approved by the Probation Department. Cashier's Check, Money Order, Cash or Debit/Credit Card are the only forms of payment that will be accepted. **We do not accept personal checks!!** Failure to pay as directed will result in a Violation of Probation.

I further understand that if I am granted permission to be in another state, or if I should be there without permission and my return to Indiana is authorized, I hereby waive extradition to the State of Indiana and agree not to contest efforts to affect such return.

STANDARD CONDITIONS:

1. You must not commit another criminal offense or your probation may be revoked. If you violate a condition of probation during the probationary period, a petition to revoke probation may be filed before the earlier of the following:
 - (A) One (1) year after the termination of probation.
 - (B) Forty-five (45) days after the state receives notice of the violation.
2. If you are arrested or contacted by a law enforcement officer for any reason, you shall notify your Probation Officer.
3. You shall report to your Probation Officer as he shall direct and truthfully answer all reasonable inquiries.
4. You shall permit visits by your Probation Officer at reasonable times at your residence or elsewhere at **any time**, without prior notice, without Warrant or Court Order and make reasonable inquiry into your activities and others in the home.
5. You shall submit to reasonable searches of your person and property: including any computer or electronic device used to send, receive, transmit or store any type of electronic data or images by any Police, Police K9 Dog, Field Officer or Probation Officer (**at the discretion of your Probation Officer**) at any time; including any residence you occupy, to ensure compliance with the conditions of your probation.

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6. You shall notify your Probation Officer of any change in your residence/living address from that listed above **PRIOR** to moving.
7. You shall not remove your residence from _____ County without first obtaining written permission from your Probation Officer. If granted written permission to leave Indiana, you shall agree to waive any/all extradition proceedings and voluntarily return when so ordered by this Court.
8. You shall notify your Probation Officer of any change in your employment within **forty-eight (48) hours** of making said change.
9. You shall work faithfully at suitable employment or faithfully pursue a course of study or vocational training that will equip you for suitable employment. You shall support your legal dependents, if any, to the best of your ability and meet all other family responsibilities.
10. You shall refrain from possessing a firearm or other deadly weapon unless granted written permission by the court or your probation officer.
11. You shall not use, possess or consume any alcoholic beverages (or enter any place where they are sold as the primary commodity; i.e., Bars, Nightclubs, Liquor Stores, etc.) narcotic drug, synthetic form of any illegal drug or controlled substance unless prescribed by a licensed health care professional and you shall permit any type of test or sample to be taken for the purpose of discovering alcohol or drug use at the request of any probation officer, anyone acting upon the request of the Probation Department or upon order of this Court. **You shall waive any objection to the admissibility of the results of the test as they are received by the Court into evidence at any Revocation Hearing.** You shall take all medications as directed by the prescribing physician and will be subject to a **MEDICATION COUNT** at anytime at the request of any probation officer, anyone acting upon the request of the Probation Department or upon order of this Court. The validity of any prescriptions will be considered on a case-by-case basis.
12. You shall report, upon a maximum of **three (3)** hours notice, to submit to any drug or alcohol test and be responsible for any costs associated with such testing. You must present a valid prescription for any prescribed medication as directed by the Probation Officer. You shall provide an acceptable sample as determined by the Probation Officer.
13. You are not to be found in the immediate vicinity of any person using illegal drugs. You shall not possess or have in your residence that you occupy any items associated with the use, administration or ingestion of illegal drugs.
14. All clients will be required to be assessed by your Probation Officer through the Indiana Risk Assessment System (IRAS) and comply with any recommendations of a case plan created by the Probation Officer, as a result of the IRAS. This may include but is not limited to alcohol/drug education, alcohol/drug counseling, self-help meetings, mental health counseling, evidence based programming, GED/diploma education, anger management, etc. You are required to submit proof of such recommendations to your Probation Officer as requested.

ADDITIONAL CASE SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:

- () You shall make an appointment with the local community mental health center within ten (10) days from this date for an evaluation and you shall satisfactorily complete any recommended treatment. You shall be responsible for the costs of any program on a timely basis and shall **SIGN A RELEASE OF INFORMATION FOR SAID AGENCY** to forward information to the probation department.
